

Guest Policies & Information

Guest Policy

Guests of members are welcome in the clubhouse, on the golf course, on the racquets courts, at the pool and at Club events unless specifically noted otherwise. Guests must be accompanied by a member at all times. Members are requested to advise guests regarding Club rules and attire.

Guests on the golf course may not play more than twice in a 30-day period.

At the request of a member, the Executive Committee may extend the privileges of the Club to one (1), two (2) or three (3) persons temporarily residing with a member as a guest, for up to two (2) weeks provided that the name and address of the guest(s) is registered with the General Manager. These privileges are not extended more than once in any calendar year.

These guests may use of the clubhouse and dining facilities as well as the Golf Course, Tennis Courts, Paddle Tennis Courts and Swimming Pool, subject to all such fees and rules as may apply.

Members are responsible for their guests' conduct and for any debts incurred by them to the Club.

Children

Except at Club functions designed for children, children under fourteen (14) years of age are not permitted in the Clubhouse (including locker rooms) unless accompanied by an adult member of the Club who is responsible for them. No one under the age of twenty-one (21) is allowed to sit at the Grill Room Bar.

Electronic Devices

Cell Phones must always be in silent mode while on property. We realize limited use of cellphones is necessary and we ask that you please be discreet during these times. Cell phone and electronic device verbal communications are only permitted in the parking lot and locker rooms.

In the main Clubhouse, tablets and laptops are only permitted for use in the Locker Rooms and the Treehouse. We ask that you kindly remove earbuds or headphones while in the main Clubhouse.

Gratuities

No member or guest shall give any gratuity to anyone employed by the Club.

Dress Code

Members are expected to observe the dress code and are responsible for ensuring observance by their family members and guests. "Country Club Appropriate" is strongly encouraged. Proper attire and a neat appearance are required throughout the Club.

Clubhouse Dress Code

(all areas of clubhouse including patios, simulators and bowling alleys, but excludes locker rooms)

Men & Boys:

- Appropriate pants or shorts (no cargo) with belt.
- Tucked in collared shirts.
- Tennis whites are permitted.
- Hats must be removed upon entering the clubhouse (excluding locker room and pro shop)
- No bathing suits or pool apparel.

Women & Girls:

- Appropriate skirts, pants, shorts or dresses.
- Tennis whites are permitted.
- No midriff baring tops.
- No bathing suits or pool apparel.

Neat denim pants, shirts or jackets with appropriate cut, in excellent repair, and without holes or tears are permitted in the clubhouse for both men and women.

In order to accommodate the winter sports season, Paddle and Bowling attire may now be worn in the clubhouse from November 1 through March 31 with the exception that our normal Dress Code (above) applies on Friday and Saturday nights.

Golf

The following applies to adults and children of any age on the golf course, the practice putting green and the practice range.

Men & Boys:

- Golf shorts or pants with belt.
- Tucked in collared shirt.
- Spikeless golf shoes or rubber-soled shoes.
- Hat/visors must be worn with bill facing forward.

Women & Girls:

- Golf skirts, shorts or skorts.
- Collared golf shirt with sleeves or without. No racer-back shirts.
- Spikeless golf shoes or rubber-soled shoes.
- Hats/visors must be worn with bill facing forward.
- Leggings are only to be worn as a base layer or part of layering.

Denim jeans of any style, short-shorts or mini-skirts, cut-offs, tank tops, bathing suits, cargo pants and shorts, tennis apparel or men's and boys' shirts without collars are not permitted.

Tennis & Pickleball

- White tennis attire is required.
- Women and girls must wear tennis dresses or tennis tops with skirts or shorts.
- Men and boys must wear tennis shorts and tennis shirts.
- Colored outerwear is allowed to be worn over whites.
- Colored hats and tennis shoes are permitted.
- Only regulation tennis shoes are permitted.

Pool

- Modest bathing suits are required in the pool and pool area.
- Neat denim pants with appropriate cut, in excellent repair, and without holes or tears are permitted. No demin skirts, shorts or cut-offs. No cargo shorts.
- All baseball caps must be worn in the proper forward position.
- Shoes and proper cover up and/or shirt are required when entering and exiting the pool area.

The General Manager, Dining Room Manager, Golf and Racquets Professionals, Caddie Master, Pool Director along with House, Golf, Tennis, and Pool Committees are authorized to enforce the Dress Codes.

Smoking Policy

Smoking is Allowed:

- On the golf course and practice areas
- In the Treehouse
- Parking Lot
- Exceptions will be considered for specific events upon Board approval.

Smoking is Not Allowed:

- On the Putting Green during dining hours (11am evening)
- At any time on the Patios

E-cigarettes, vaping products and cannabis of any form are not permitted.
